| Blonde Moment | Stamps | 3.6% | Golden Ale | Liverpool | A pale coloured beer using predominantly Citra hops producing a smooth floral and citrus aroma and flavour. |
| Flaxen | Hophurst Brewery | 3.7% | Golden Ale | Wigan | An English pale golden ale. East Kent Golding hops give a fresh, earthy hoppy aroma with hints of honey and a long refreshing finish. |
| Chronicle | High Weald | 3.8% | Session Ale | West Sussex | Brewed using the classic combination of English Fuggles and Goldings hops, this has all the qualities of a fine session ale. |
| 1863 Best Bitter | Issac Poad | 3.8% | Bitter | York | A traditional bitter that combines the finest Maris Otter malt with traditional English hops. Well balanced, bronze in colour, smooth and easy drinking. |
| Brewsmith Bitter | Brewsmith | 3.9% | Bitter | Lancashire | Moderate bitterness, pronounced floral and citrus aromas. Using Chinook, Savinjski Golding, Citra, Willamette hops along with LC Maris Otter, Wheat Malt, Caramalt, Oats. |
| Darkheart Mild | Yorkshire Heart | 4% | Mild | York | Roasted Coffee colour with smooth, rich treacle flavours. A proper smooth, enjoyable Mild! |
| DDH | Old Dairy Brewery | 4% | Pale Ale | Tenterden | A Double Dry Hopped Pale Ale, brewed with Citra and Mosaic hops. |
| Spirit of Tenterden | Old Dairy Brewery | 4% | Bitter | Tenterden | Kentish Bitter, rich, full flavoured bitter with a fruity bite. |
| Legion | Dow Bridge | 4.1% | Golden Ale | Leicestershire | Golden hoppy ale. A good balance of malt and fruity hops on the nose and palate. |
| Barnes Wallis | Amber Ales | 4.1% | Bitter | Derbyshire | IPA-style bitter, copper-coloured for a full malt flavour and hopped with Northern Brewer and spicy Syrian Goldings. |
| Radical | Kirby Lonsdale | 4.2% | Bitter | Lancashire | A ruby red beer brewed with a selection of Maris Otter, crystal and black malts. |
| Cragg Bitter | Little Valley | 4.2% | Bitter | West Yorkshire | Bold and malty. |
| Heritage | Three Castles | 4.2% | Bitter | Wiltshire | A chestnut bronze bitter with a smooth taste. 'A traditional English beer'. |
| Simcoe | Old Dairy Brewery | 4.2% | Pale Ale | Tenterden | A light, refreshing session pale ale, brewed with USA Simcoe hops. |
| Golden Valley | Rother Valley Brewery | 4.2% | Golden Ale | Northiam | Brewed with lager and wheat malts for a golden colour, a fresh hop bitterness with rolling zesty waves. |
| Meditation Pale Ale | Turpins Ale | 4.3% | Pale Ale | Oxfordshire | A beautiful pale ale with blackcurrant, grapefruit and tropical fruit flavours, complex taste of bitterness, hints of apricot, herbs and punchy floral notes. |
| Honey Blonde | Downton Brewery | 4.3% | Golden Bitter | Wiltshire | A golden straw coloured bitter. A superb blend of spicy and floral hops, added to the smooth sweetness imparted by Flaked Maize and Mexican honey. |
| Game Keeper | Wensleydale | 4.3% | Bitter | Yorkshire | A Yorkshire Best Bitter with a modern edge. Rich copper in colour with malty and slightly biscuity flavours, Magnum hops give a subtle hoppy finish. |
| Classic | Bushy's Brewery Ltd | 4.3% | Ruby Ale | Isle Of Man | A complex, rich ruby ale, full fruit and malt on the palate. A balanced citrus aroma follows, resulting in a real connoisseur ale in a true Burton style. |
| Franc 'in' Stein | Flipside | 4.3% | Golden Ale | Nottingham | A golden ale, with a peachy, melon and soft fruit flavour, with an initial sweet citrus flavour and dry finish. |

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| Premium | Slaters | 4.4% | Amber Ale | Staffordshire | Rich amber coloured beer with hints of caramel, malt and a complex fruity hop aroma developing a bitter finish and balancing the well rounded 'malty mouthfeel'. |
| Sharp's Original | Sharp's | 4.4% | Bitter | Cornwall | Rich roasted and malty notes are key to the aroma of Original with light hop tones. An authentic and moreish example of a traditional English Ale. |
| Decadance | Brewsters | 4.4% | Golden Ale | Lincolnshire | A golden ale with a hint of malt sweetness. First taste gives a complex zesty hop palate leading on to a fresh herby finish. |
| Devonshire Pale Ale | Black Tor Brewery | 4.5% | Pale Ale | Devon | Thirst quenching, easy drinking, well balanced and well hopped pale ale brewed with English and American hops, with citrus flavours, floral aromas and a crisp dry finish. |
| Gobble | Great Oakley | 4.5% | Golden Ale | Northamptonshire | Gobble is a rich, golden, straw coloured beer. Floral, crisp, hoppy and nutty with a large smack of hops at the end giving a fantastic taste sensation. |
| Talwar | Reunion | 4.5% | Pale Ale | London | A light, crisp, very pale beer. Infused with coriander seeds, the taste is very clean with a zingy, zesty finish. The aroma is resinous and spicy. |
| Jack The Devil | Cullercoats Brewery | 4.5% | Brown Ale | Tyne & Wear | Delicious and rich, a mid brown, chestnut coloured ale made from Maris Otter barley and the finest English aromatic hops. Perfect balance of malty nuttiness and a fresh hoppy aroma. |
| Pirates Gold | Muirhouse | 4.5% | Golden Ale | Derbyshire | Gold coloured bitter packed with admiral hops. |
| Charington I.P.A. | Heritage | 4.5% | Bitter / IPA | Burton Upon Trent | A malty aroma with resinous English hop notes. It has a pleasant hoppy bite leading to a smooth malty flavour. |
| O.P.M | Rother Valley Brewery | 4.6% | English Ale | Northiam | Brewed with organic pale malt, a classic English hop taste from Challenger hops and a subtle biscuit flavour from the malt, amber in colour. |
| Fuggle-Dee-Dum | Goddard's Brewery | 4.8% | English Bitter | Isle of Wight | A chestnut, tawny red premium ale. Brewed with roasted malts and English Fuggle hops, to give a smoky, spicy hoppiness on the nose, leading to a molasses, nutty palate with a light fruity hop dryness. |
| Spingo Middle | The Blue Anchor Brewery | 5% | Bitter | Cornwall | Originally brewed to welcome home those men who fought in the First World War. It is a traditional sweet Cornish bitter, with an unforgettable flavour. |
| Ten Fifty | Grainstore | 5% | Bitter | Rutland | A full strength mahogany coloured beer, possessing the fine balance of pronounced hop bitterness & aroma against a natural malty sweetness. |
| Pendle Witches Brew | Moorhouses | 5.1% | Amber Ale | Lancashire | A bold, malty amber beer with spicy fruit notes and crisp fruity aftertaste. |
| Gone Fishing ESB | Green Jack | 5.5% | Bitter | Suffolk | A traditional in style, even though it is brewed with American hops. A deep amber coloured ale, fruity and malty - it goes down far too easily for a beer of this strength. |
| Divination IPA | Wishbone Brewery | 5.6% | IPA | West Yorkshire | Dry hopped American IPA stuffed full of Chinook, Ahtanum, Columbus & Summit hops. |
| Old Peculier | Theakston | 5.6% | Old Ale | North Yorkshire | Brewed using a blend of pale, crystal and roasted barley, with two bitter hops combined with Fuggles hops to produce a full-bodied flavour with subtle cherry and rich fruit overtones. |
| Jaipur IPA | Thornbridge Brewery | 5.9% | IPA | Derbyshire | A balance of Chinook, Centennial, Ahtanum, Simcoe, Columbus and Cascade hops, with Maris Otter malt, make this a very complex I.P.A with powerful citrus flavours and a smooth finish. |
| Wobbly Bob | Phoenix | 6% | Brown Ale | Manchester | A mid brown ale with a malt & hop aroma, with a bitter & hoppy finish. |
| Spingo Special | The Blue Anchor Brewery | 6.5% | Dark | Cornwall | Brewed for the first time to celebrate the marriage of Prince Charles and Diana, this magnificent beer is dark in colour and sweet in taste. |
