Ciders

Old Rosie – 7.3% - Westons (Medium)

Mid golden and straw like in colour, Old Rosie is a cloudy medium bodied fruity cider that has a wonderful aroma of wild berry fruits, honey and vintage barrels.

Pig Squeal – 7% - Snails Bank, Herefordshire (Dry)

Named after the delightful sound of pigs when they come across some windfall apples! Like these pigs this is full of character. A rich bronze cider that is smooth as it is tasty. Beautifully balanced with a satisfying rounded finish.

Double Vision – 6.9% - Double Vision, Maidstone, Kent (Dry)

Dry Cider made with a blend of different apples from Kent.

Strawberry Cider – 5.2% - Double Vision, Maidstone, Kent (Medium)

A fine fruit cider from Kent.

Moonshine – 7.5% - Broadoak Cider Company, East Sussex (Medium, Dry)

Strong and very drinkable with a crisp refreshing taste and little evidence of alcoholic content.

Mango – 4% - Broadoak Cider Company, East Sussex (Medium)

An indulgent rich and fruity blend of our Somerset cider and Indian mango, imparting a finely balanced medium sweet taste with an invitingly fragrant aroma.

Pineapple and Passionfruit – 4% - Farmer Jims, Devon (Medium)

A medium apple cider expertly blended with exotic fruits.

Tenterden – 5.5% - Nightingales, Tenterden, Kent (Medium)

Tenterden cider celebrates the connection between our orchards and hometown in the Weald of Kent. A beautifully balanced, bright and floral medium still cider. A wild fermented minimal intervention cider, which is matured for a minimum of 6 months before release.

Russet – 8.1% - Nightingales, Tenterden, Kent (Dry)

Our single variety Russet cider is a strong, complex and nutty dry cider, that captures the minerality of the Wealden soil, and is aged before release.
