**Pineapple Dream 4.1%, Three Acre Brewery, Blackboy, East Sussex**

Bursting with pineapple and soft toffee flavours. Light in colour

**Best Bitter 4%, Three Acre Brewery, Blackboy, East Sussex**

Great tasting Traditional Style bitter. Award winning

**Session Pale 3.7%, Three Acre Brewery, Blackboy, East Sussex**

Low on ABV. Big on Flavour

**Summertime 4%, Lister's Brewery, Worthing**

A light hopping ale, pale ochre in colour, perfectly refreshing for the summer months

**Best Bitter 3.8%, Lister's Brewery, Worthing**

Traditional in style, but triple hopped giving it a deep and lasting finish. It is amber in colour, full flavoured, balanced and moreish

**Special Ale 4.6%, Lister's Brewery, Worthing**

A premium bitter. It is dark, rich to malty. Russet brown in colour with roasted and toasted malted. It is smooth to satisfying

**Happy Hound 3.8%, Lister's Brewery, Worthing**

A russet brown session ale that is smooth and slightly malty with a satisfying lasting bitterness

**The Bounder 3.8%, Leatherbritches Brewery, Ashby De-La-Zouch, Leicestershire**

Includes lychees, grapefruit to spicy notes leads to a crisp bitter finish

**Pressed Rat to Waterhog 3.8%, Triple FFF Brewery, Alton, Hampshire**

Ruby coloured complex mild. Dark chocolate aroma with hints of blackcurrant and plum, leading to a soft yet full roast flavour and hoppy bittersweet finish

**The Quiet American 4.2% APA, Kent Brewery, Birling Kent**

Session American Pale Ale

**Cobnut 4.1%, Kent Brewery, Birling Kent**

A Ruby Ale

**Smooth Operator 4.9%. Kent Brewery, Birling Kent**

Oatcream Stout. A luxurious sweet and smooth cream stout with a hint of chocolate and a delicious roasted body

**Hillfast Best Bitter 4%, Blue Bee Brewery, Sheffield**

A traditional Chestnut coloured best bitter with roast malt flavours and fruity hop finish

**Goldffinger 5%, Triple FFF Brewery, Alton, Hampshire**

A cask conditioned real lager. Brewed with Lager Malt and traditional Lager Yeast. Crisp, dry with a hint of sweetness

### **Coppernob 3.8%, Tonbridge Brewery, Tonbridge, Kent**

A medium dry copper coloured ale with a biscuit and caramel maltiness. Kentish Golding, Challenger and Fuggles hops provide a robust hoppy finish

### **Blonde Ambition 4.2% Tonbridge Brewery, Tonbridge, Kent**

A fully flavoured, well bittered and refreshing blonde ale. Kent Challenger and First Gold hops provide a crisp, clean tasting, spicy and citrus finish.

### **Rustic 4%, Tonbridge Brewery, Tonbridge, Kent**

A deep bronze coloured, rich tasting country ale. The scarce Kent grown Epic and classic Fuggles varieties provide a smooth, delicate spicy finish

### **Level Best 4%, Rother Valley Brewery, Rye**

Full-bodied tawny session bitter with a malt and fruit aroma, malty taste and a dry, clear hoppy finish

### **Blues 5%, Rother Valley Brewery, Rye**

(Porter) Smoky, barbeque aromas with some roast coffee notes. Burnt malt flavours mixed with a dark chocolate bitterness, more coffee tones and a dry bitterness on the finish

### **NIPA 5%, Rother Valley Brewery, Rye**

Northern Indian Pale Ale. A traditional IPA brewed with the classic English Admiral hops. Golden in colour, it is both bitter and sweet

### **UXB 4.6%, Wantsum Brewery, St Nicholas At Wade, Kent**

Raspberry Porter. Pleasant raspberry flavours twinned with chocolate roastiness.

### **Thunderbolt 6%, Wantsum Brewery, St Nicholas At Wade, Kent**

Super Hoppy IPA, slightly hazy

### **Ravening Wolf 5.9%, Wantsum Brewery, St Nicholas At Wade, Kent**

New Zealand IPA. A strong New Zealand pale ale. Toasted IPA biscuit and Rye Malt flavours support a pine lemon hop crispness with a hint of vanilla

### **Black Dog Mild, 3.6%, Elgoods Brewery, Wisbech, Cambridge**

Award-winning cask dark mild, full of flavour

### **Full Steam Ahead 4.8% (IPA). Isle of Purbeck Brewery, Dorset**

The English Style pale ale is characterised by a hearty helping and English hop character to the flavour and aroma, offering a contrast to the Earthy English hop additions

### **She Sells Sea Shells 4.7%, Ramsgate Brewery, Broadstairs**

A pale ale with a clean, fresh bitterness and a gorgeous zesty hop flavour

### **Gadds No.5 4.4%, Ramsgate Brewery, Broadstairs**

A rusty red proper bitter ale. Varieties of hops for flavour. Look out for notes of toffee, red berry and spicy blackcurrant

### **Summer Pale 4.2%, Iron Pier Brewery, Northfleet, Kent**

Refreshingly fruity pale ale brewed with Dana and Hallertau blanc hops

### **Milk Stout 4.2%, Iron Pier, Northfleet, Kent**

Delicious rich and velvety stout with undertones of chocolate and coffee. Subtle sweetness with a dark malt bitterness

### **Old Ale 4.3%, Iron Pier Brewery, Northfleet, Kent**

Dark and full bodied, with washed malt, subtle dried fruit flavours and a light bitterness to finish

### **Wealdaway 4.5%, Iron Pier Brewery, Northfleet, Kent**

IPA. Brewed using mosaic, chin oak, Syrian Cordial and Columbus hops, resulting in a wealth of fruit and spiced flavours and a pine back note

### **Whispering Grass 5.5%, Pig 'N' Porter, Tunbridge Wells**

IPA

### **Jumping Frog 4.2%, Pig 'N' Porter, Tunbridge Wells**

With aromas and flavours of pineapple, grapefruit, a bit of pine and stone fruit. Sabro and Citra at the dry hop stage

### **Got The Face On 4.5%, Pig 'N' Porter, Tunbridge Wells**

Wheat and oat additions in this beer boost the mouthfeel and body, along with Citra, EXP431 and Vic Secret hops, bring out flavours of mandarins, nectarines and melon

### **Reeves Ale 4.1%, Canterbury**

A tawny copper best bitter with nutty malts and berry fruit hops

### **Miller's Ale 4.3%, Canterbury**

A rich red best bitter with toffee malts, rich fruity hops and a very smooth hoppy finish

### **The Merchant's Ale 4%, Canterbury**

A smooth, mild black stout with gentle roast malts and soft fruity hop notes and a clean fruity finish

### **Best Bitter 4%, Long Man Brewery, Polegate, East Sussex**

Perfectly balanced with a complex bittersweet, malty taste, fragrant hops and a characteristic deep finish. A traditional Sussex Style Best Bitter

### **Long Blonde 3.8%, Long Man Brewery, Polegate, East Sussex**

A light coloured golden ale with a distinctive hoppy aroma and a crisp clean bitterness on the finish, smooth, light and refreshing

### **Copper Hop 4.2%, Long Man Brewery, Polegate, East Sussex**

Vienna and premium British caramalt, provide a well balanced backbone for intense tropical fruit aromas
